



The Tucson Interfaith HIV/AIDS Network (TIHAN) has been designated as a Qualifying Charitable Organization by the State of Arizona. (TIHAN's QCO Code is 20359.)

You may be able to reduce, dollar-for-dollar, what you pay in Arizona state income tax or increase your refund.

Your gift will help people with HIV to live as well as possible. Direct your Arizona tax credit dollars and support YOUR values, priorities, and organizations such as TIHAN that are important to you. *Keep YOUR tax dollars local!*

Couples who file jointly can reduce their state taxes by up to \$800. Individuals or head of household filers can claim a tax credit of up to \$400. This is <u>in addition to</u> the school tax credit!

The state of Arizona will give you a credit of up to \$400 if you file as an individual, or \$800 if you file as a married couple. So if you are a single person who wants to donate \$200 to TIHAN, you could give \$600, and you can get a refund of \$400 from state of Arizona when you file your taxes. (Or if you are married, you could get up to \$800 tax credit returned to you when you file your taxes).

If you are planning to make a donation to TIHAN, please consider the Arizona State Tax Credit.
